Shri. D. D. Vispute College of Pharmacy & Research Centre Devad-Vichumbe the Second party, and represented herein by its Centre Head / Principal, SDDVCP & RC Devad-Vichumbe.

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Technical Education Institution named: Government Polytechnic, Pen.
- B) Second Party is an institute engaged in Skill Based Training, Education, and Placements, named: Shri. D. D. Vispute College of Pharmacy & Research Centre.
- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and enhance teaching learning process.
- D) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training. Education, Placement, Educational Visit, Expert Lecture.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), the parties hereto agree as follows:

CLAUSE 1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they will co-operate with each other as promptly as possible to make it most relevant and practical agreement.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party believe that the Co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities.





CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Technical Training & Visits: Technical Institution and Pharmacy Institution interaction will provide an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the pharmaceutical technology related to Instrumentation and Control Engineering field and Chemical Engineering field; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its well-equipped laboratories and involve in Technical Training Programs for the First Party. Also the Second party may register on the AICTE Internship Portal for the benefit of the students.
- 2.2 Expert Lectures: Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver expert lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.3 Placement of students: Second party will actively engage to help the placement of the students from Instrumentation and Control Engineering and Chemical Engineering.
- 2.4 First party agrees to provide infrastructure facilities and services of faculty members for troubleshooting and repair the equipment/ instruments available in laboratories used by Second party if they need. The financial consideration, involved in this activity, if any, will be decided separately by mutual consent.

CLAUSE 3 VALIDITY

3.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is explicitly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms. In case either of the parties decides to withdraw the MoU, it can do so by giving 30 days' notice in writing. However before such exit occurs each of the parties should complete the commitments to each other, so that students will not suffer.

CLAUSE 4 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

4.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent entities, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership.
